U of S Ag Tour/Canadian Light Source - 9:00 a.m. − 2:00 p.m.

Simply put, a synchrotron is an extremely powerful source of X-rays. The X-rays are produced by high energy electrons as

they circulate around the **synchrotron**. ... A **synchrotron** machine exists to accelerate electrons to extremely high energy and then make them change direction periodically.

We'll take you on a 1 hour tour of the <u>Canadian Light Source</u> (synchrotron) at the University of Saskatchewan, then bus you to the <u>Rayner Dairy Research and Teaching Facility</u> on campus where the Poultry Extension department will guide you through the dairy and briefly present current poultry research.
